SoHumane Adoptions by Appointment Canceled Today

MEDFORD, Ore, - The Southern Oregon Humane Society has paused the **Adoptions by Appointment** process effective immediately. With reference to Governor Kate Brown's Executive Order No. 20-12 Stay Home, Save Lives, the risk to staff, volunteers and our community is believed to be too great to continue showing adoptable dogs and cats while practicing social distancing protocols. The Adoption Center will remain closed until further notice. These steps are being taken out of an abundance of caution and to reduce the spread of the novel coronavirus in our community. All prospective adopters with prior appointments to see animals will be contacted today.

SoHumane staff and volunteers will continue to care for the dogs and cats at SoHumane. Please be assured they are being given all of the love and attention they deserve including our high standard of veterinary care. We will continue to monitor the COVID-19 outbreak and keep you informed of any additional changes that may be necessary. As always, we are truly grateful for your support.
